


Transitioning from Fragmentation to a Single Operating System

The project overcomes the fragmentation of isolated interventions by uniting schools, public bodies, and the third sector into a structured, coordinated network.




1. Analysis

Definition of shared protocols and staff training





The Challenge: Fragmentation




The Solution: Nuove Radici Network



Objective: To create a structured network for the reception and school integration of migrant students.

Result: Integrated management of school migration flows rather than emergency responses.

Strategic Mapping: Beyond Numerical Data


A multidimensional analysis of foreign-born students is utilized to understand the real context, moving beyond simple headcounts to build a 360-degree profile.



The Shared Protocol: Standardizing the Approach

Definition:

The creation of a single operational tool for reception and placement across all network schools.



The Core Goals

Inter Tight




Streamlining entry procedures to minimize educational gaps.


Capacity Building and Staff Training

Target Audience: Teachers, administrative staff, vocational guidance counselors, coordinators, and tutors.



The Professional Interface: Intercultural Mediation

Core Function: Welcoming and accompanying students through the delicate phases of entry, initial placement, and guidance.



The School-Family Bridge

Helping families understand school operations and educational guidance.

Didactic Intervention

Collaborating with teachers to interpret and translate school curricula from countries of origin.

Facilitation

Support in understanding programs and didactic materials.


Targeted Models

Developing specific intervention plans for individual students and family units.

Peer Tutoring: Integration Through Horizontal Solidarity

Activation of a network of student tutors to foster socialization and informal learning.



Preparation

Tutors receive specific training in relational and basic teaching skills.



Linguistic Support

Practical help in learning the Italian language.




Study Support
